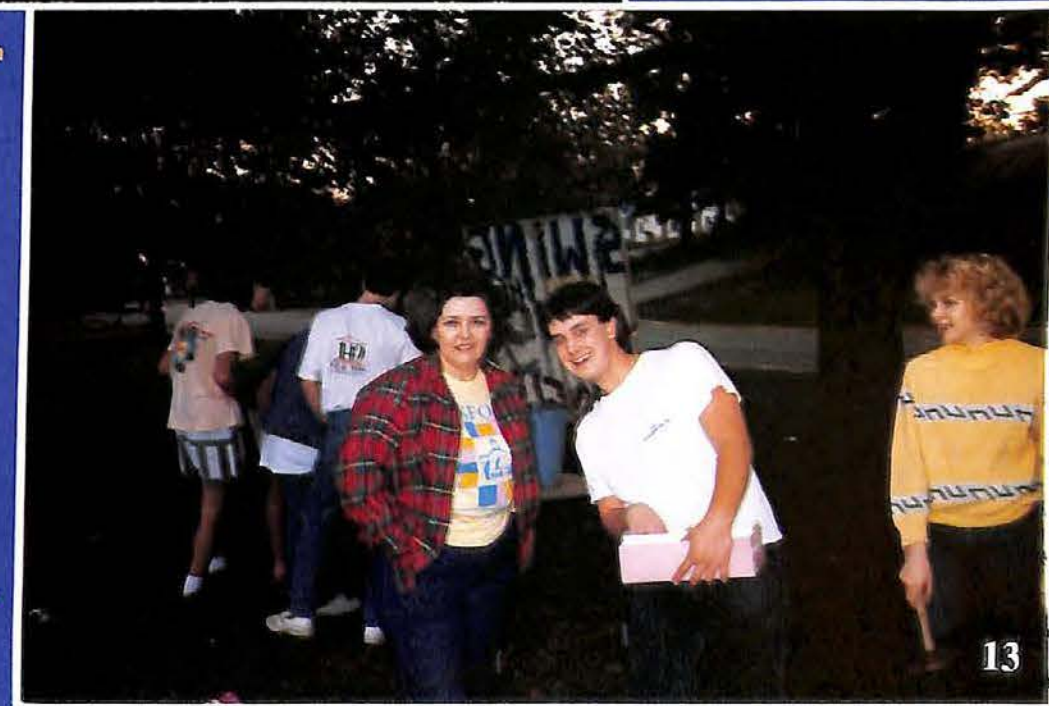
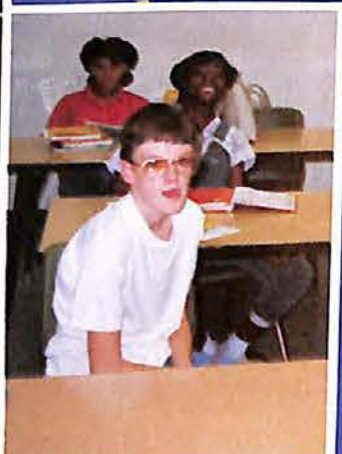














DEDICATION

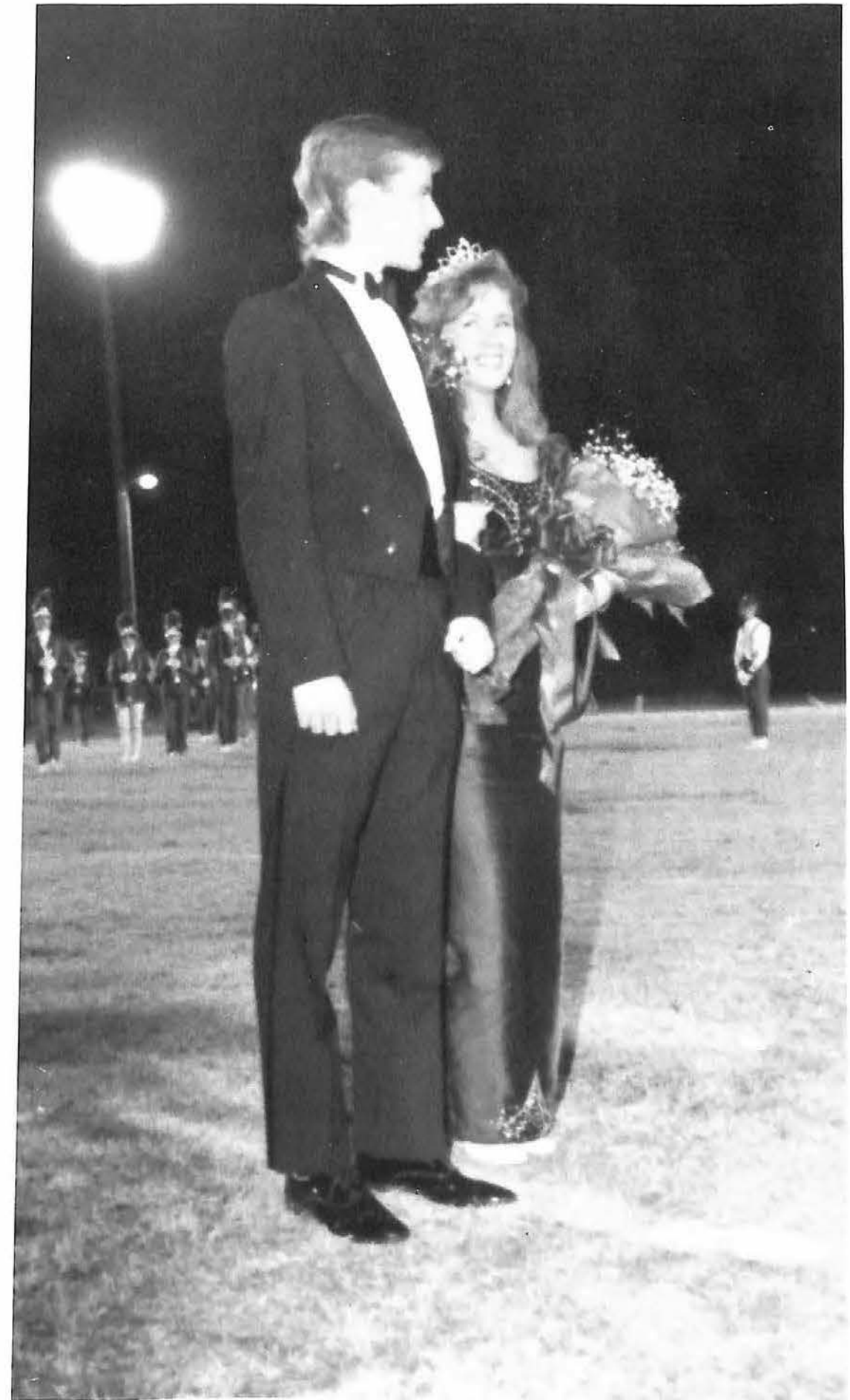
OHS HOMECOMING
