A TOUCH OF . . . FRIENDSHIP



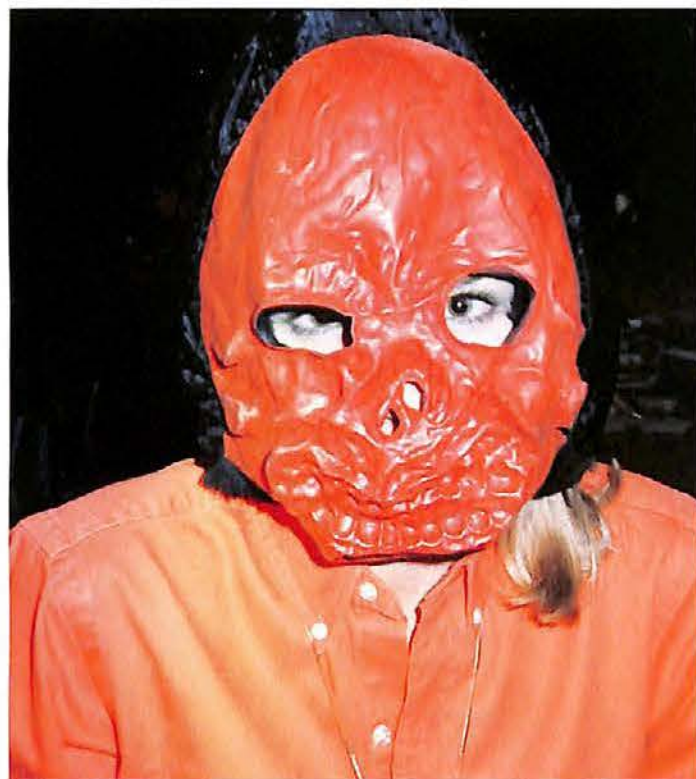

A TOUCH OF . . . SPIRIT



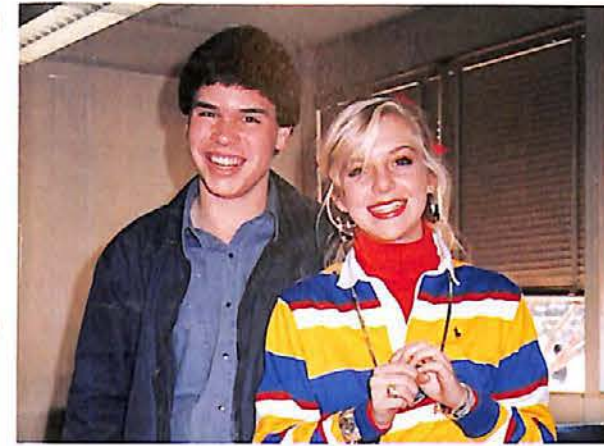

They lost their head coach, Bob Tyler. There were kids quitting or leaving for various reasons. The first week of practice there were less than 30 players out. Despite all the tragedies Coach Dupree, his staff, and his players pulled it together as a team. After Dupree was granted head Coaching honors at OHS, he gave a speech to some 37 players and 3 coaches. He is quoted as saying, "Kids, in spite of all the bad happenings we will have a team at OHS. We will have one if I only have 11 players." That inspired the boys and that enabled them to give their best every game and practice. OHS had a bad season in the record books, but in actuality Dupree, his coaches, 8 seniors, 17 juniors, and 19 sophomores laid the framework for a great future at Oxford High.

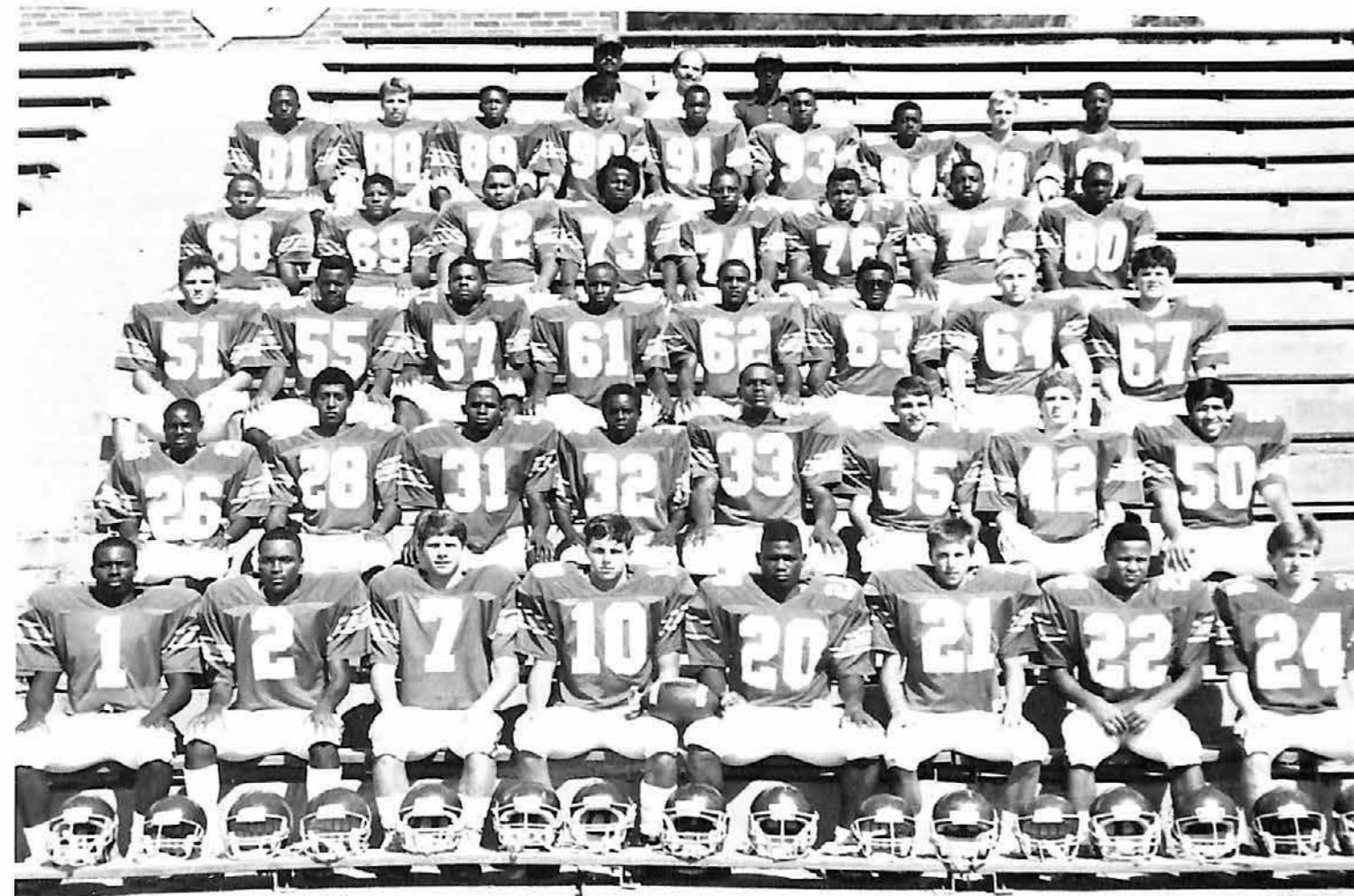
