Oxford High is very proud to have these two fine students as our 1984 seniors graduating with Special Distinction.


STAR STUDENT

The Associated Student Government at Oxford High School is made up of four branches. The Executive Branch, the Legislative Branch, the Senate, and the Judicial Branch.
