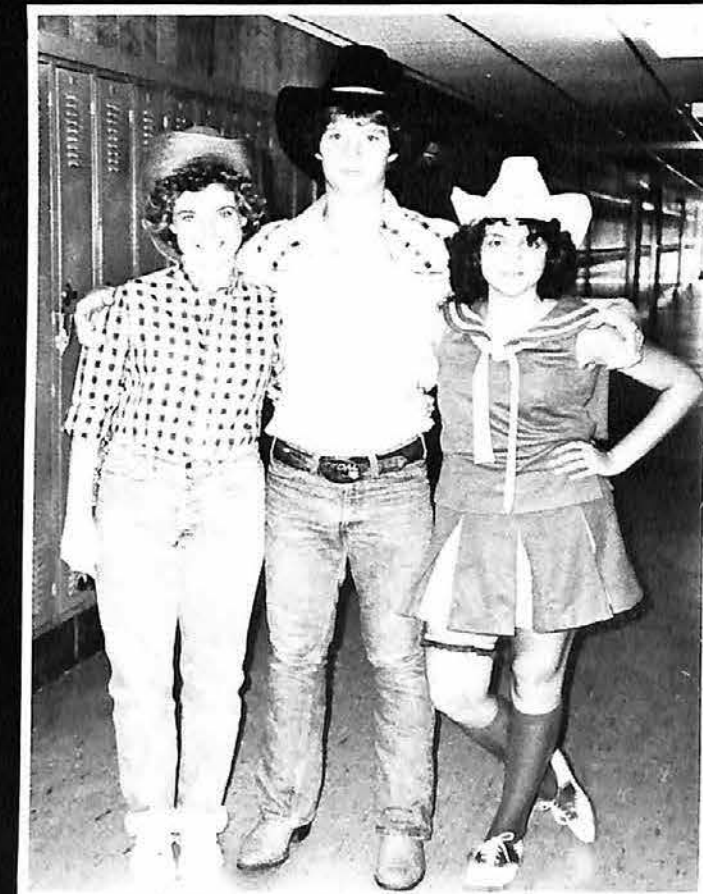


SPIRIT DAYS

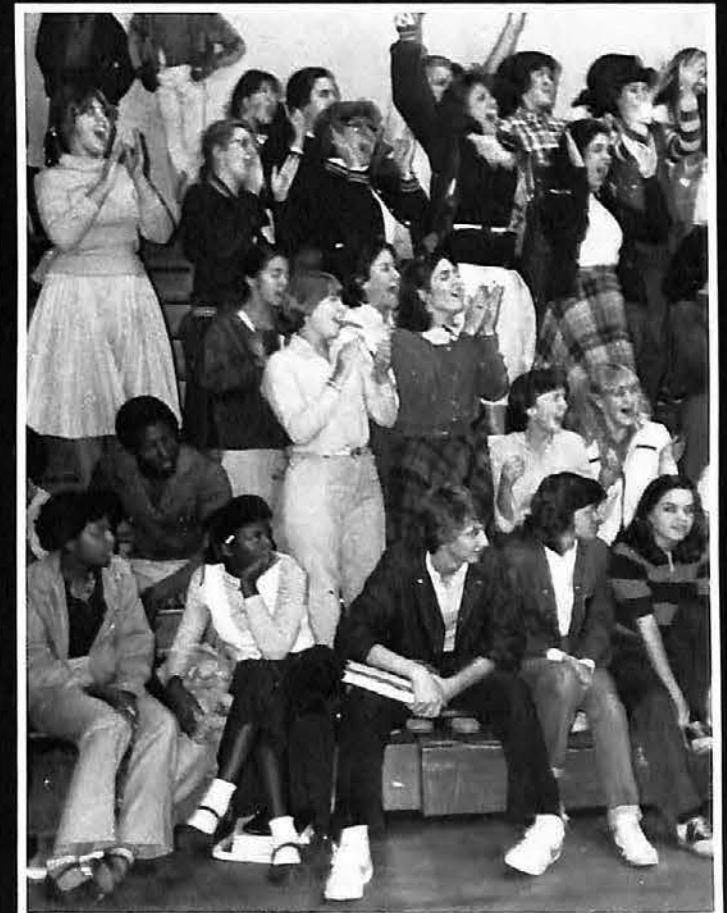


PEP RALLIES

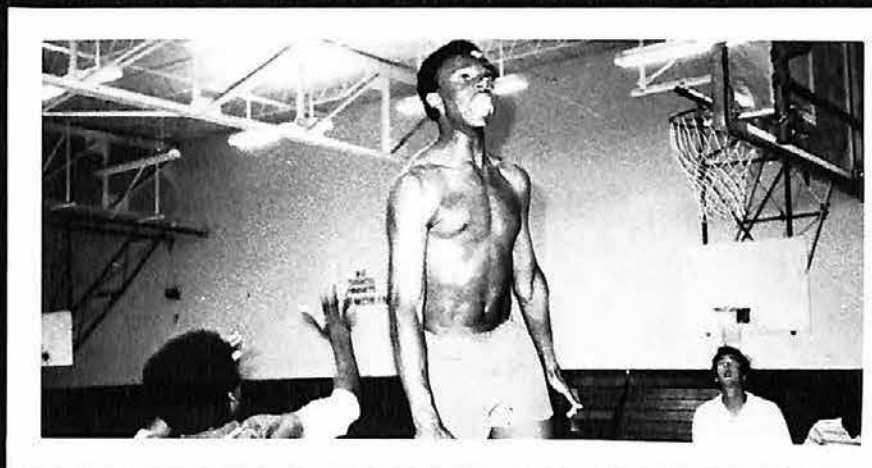
SOPHOMORES
