NATIONAL HONOR SOCIETY

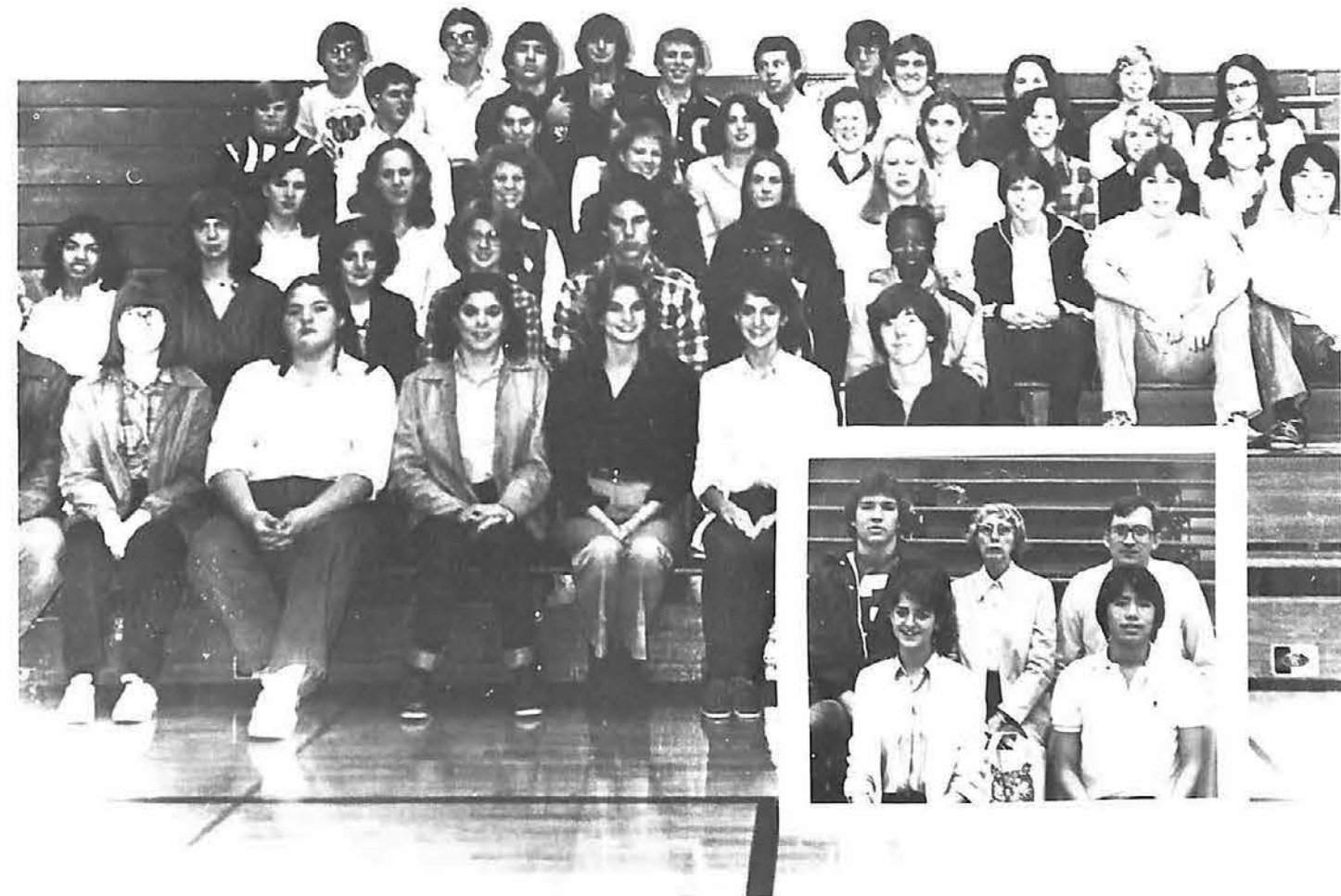

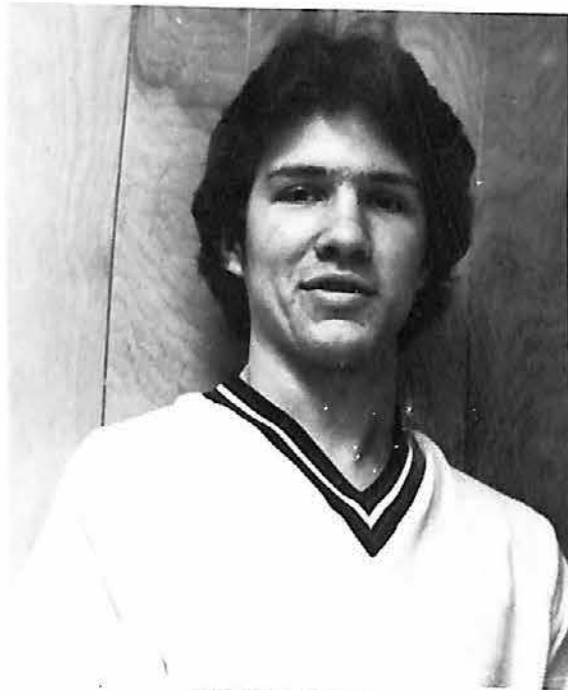

REQUIREMENTS FOR HALL OF FAME

A selection committee will be appointed to perform the clerical work involved in placing the student's activity and honor points on a rating sheet for Hall of Fame. The committee will tally the rating sheets after completion by the faculty. The scores will be averaged. Applicants will be rated on activities, clubs, honors, scholarship, cooperation, and responsibility. The twelve students with the highest total points on the rating sheet shall become eligible for membership in the Hall of Fame. Applicants are required to have participated in at least six activities. A grade point average of 3.0 is needed in order to qualify for the Hall of Fame.

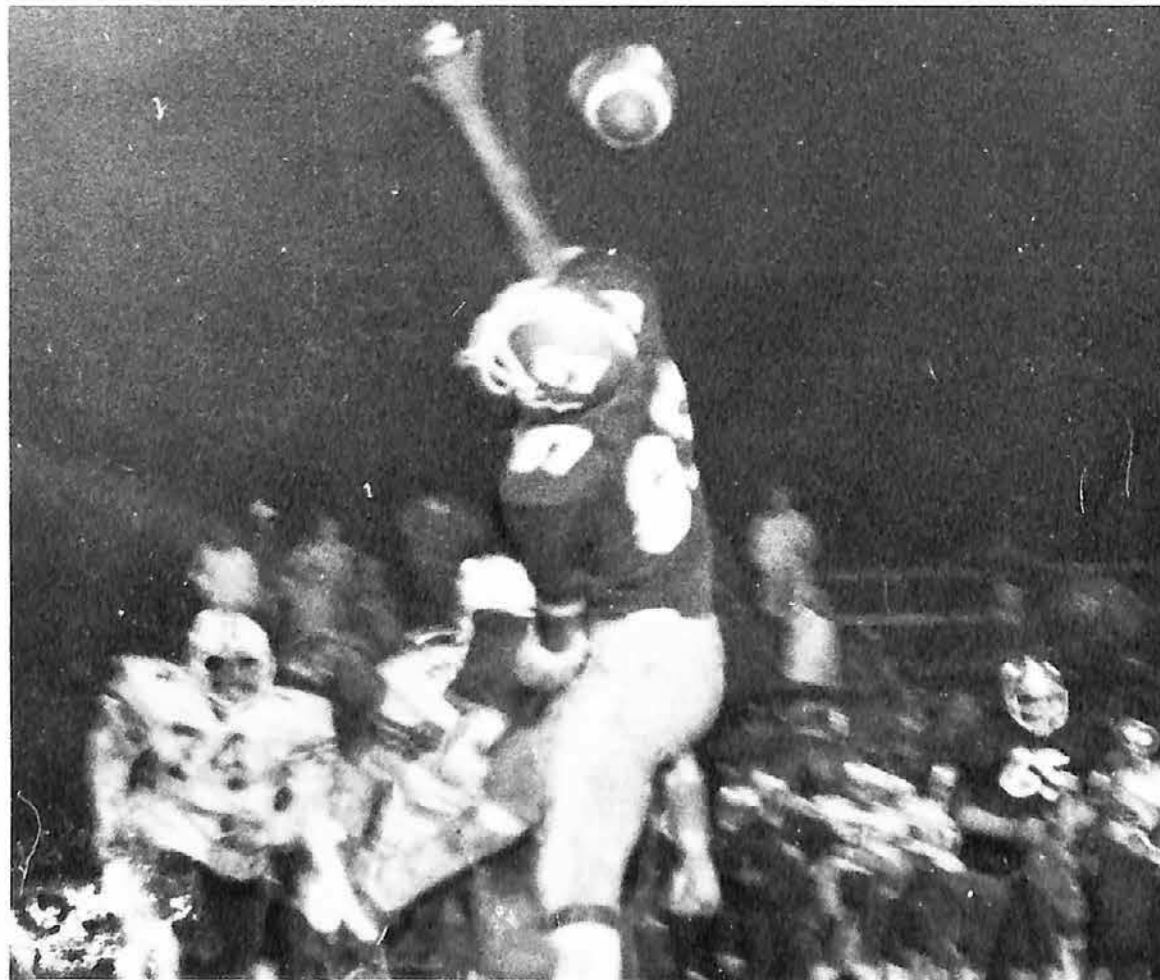
THE 1979 CHARGER FOOTBALL REVIEW

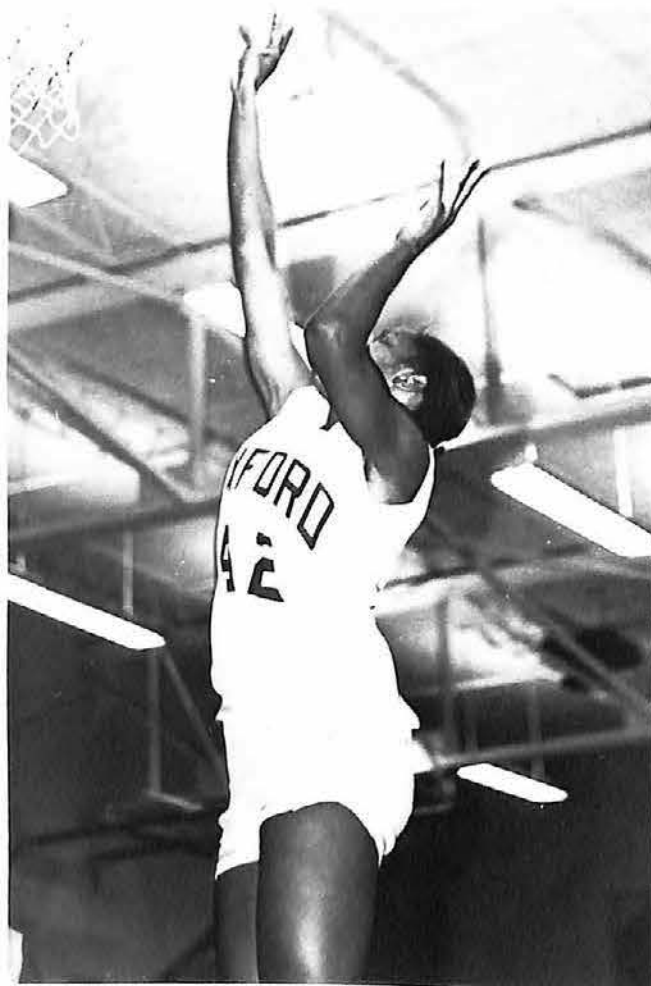
1979-80 CHARGER BASKETBALL
