
Summer Enrichment Program Overview

Dear North Plainfield Community Members:

The North Plainfield School District is proud to provide all **currently attending** North Plainfield Preschool through 11th-grade students the "no cost" opportunity to participate in a variety of Summer Enrichment experiences, in addition to the academic support available through the District Summer Learning programs.

The Summer Enrichment Program will run, Monday through Thursday, beginning June 24th and ending on Tuesday, August 20th. <u>Each session has a unique schedule and each workshop is structured to a specific age and developmental level.</u>

To every extent possible, Summer Enrichment sessions have been scheduled to run in the afternoon so as not to interfere with the Summer Learning Programs taking place in the morning, and to allow all students equal access to participation. Beginning July 1st and ending August 1st, students are also invited to participate in the <u>free, drop-in</u>,



Summer Food Service Program at West End School cafeteria and the NPHS/MS cafeteria. Services are <u>sit-down only</u>, with breakfast taking place daily, Monday - Thursday, 7:30 am to 8:30 am, and lunch from 11:00 am to 12:30 pm. Students do not need to participate in summer programming to participate in the Summer Food Service Program as it is open to all children under the age of 18.

We invite you to explore the Summer Enrichment brochure with your child(ren) to identify those programs that will help your child(ren) discover their strengths, try out new interests, build new friendships, expand social skills, stay active *and simply have fun!*

REGISTRATION IS NOW OPEN for all Summer Enrichment sessions and will be processed through the Genesis Parent Portal Forms Library. Registration will be filled on a "first-come, first-served basis," and registering for any session does not guarantee participation. Each program has a maximum capacity and final participation lists will be confirmed mid-May. Participation in any program comes with the expectation to maintain consistent attendance. Out of a spirit of fairness and consideration for all students, please only register if your child intends to go each day the session is offered.

We are truly excited to present so many opportunities to enrich your child (ren)'s summer, and hope that this enrichment program serves to support our working families and to cultivate community partnership.
