- Horizon Program is a Setting III special education behavioral program for students who qualify.
- We are a PBIS school working to create consistent language and expectations throughout the building to encourage **"Bobcats to always do their best"**.
- Student Council for grades 3 and 4 providing community and leadership opportunities.
- Safety Patrol in Grade 4 working to promote safe arrival and departure for our school.

Our teachers and staff are champions for all students, challenging them to think critically and demonstrate their knowledge and understanding in a variety of different ways to prepare students for success beyond school.
