

**Maple Park Charter
Lottery and Admissions Policies**

Section 3.10 The requirements for admission to the Charter School and admissions lottery.

- a. The Charter School is open to all students in grades 9 to 12 who (i) reside in the District or (ii) are enrolled in the District pursuant to Wis. Stat. §§ 118.51, 118.52,
- b. The Governance Board will set enrollment limits for the following school year by December 1 and submit them to the District by January 1. If the number of enrollment applications exceeds the enrollment limit, the school will select students on a random lottery basis. The Charter School will give preference to pupils and siblings of pupils who are already attending the Charter School. Open-enrolled applicants who meet the eligibility requirements and select the Charter School as a preference will be placed in the Charter School if space is available. If a student who has selected the Charter School as a preference is a student with a disability under the Individuals with Disabilities Educational Act (IDEA), placement will be determined by the IEP team in accordance with federal law.
- c. A waiting list will be maintained for students who are not selected in the random lottery. The waiting list will be utilized until September 1st of the upcoming school year to fill open seats.
- d. The District may include in its lottery all nonresident applicants who seek enrollment in the Charter School. An open-enrolled applicant's admission to the Charter School will be contingent on the student's enrollment in the District.
