## Application Scoring Process

All applications will be reviewed and scored by *The Marshall Klein Foundation Board of Directors*. The application has three scoring components: the student information form (including student transcript), the nomination form, and the student essay. These three components will be scored and weighted in the following manner. The total number of possible points will be 100 with the top scores receiving the scholarships.

Student Information Form    15 points

Student Nomination Form    30 points

Student Essay                    55 points
