

2024 2025 EXPANDED LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES PROGRAM

California state funding to expand academic and enrichment opportunities after-school

- Examples include: tutoring, physical/recreational activities, clubs/enrichment classes, and social/emotional support
- Opportunities vary by school site and are based on staff/student interest
- Opportunities will not replicate but will expand upon learning from regular school day
- After-school offerings may be taught by site level teachers or outside providers
- After-school offerings, coupled with regular school day, will provide students/families a total of 9 hours of student engagement/supervision on regular school days
- Winter, spring, and summer sessions provided, but require separate enrollment process



Prioritized Enrollment (in descending order):

- Homeless/foster students
- Students eligible for free/reduced meals
- Students needing academic support
- Remaining spaces filled by random selection of remaining applicants
