## What you should know...

### School Supplies

There is no set list of school supplies needed for freshman year. Students will find out what they specifically need as the school year begins. Most notes, text books, etc. are accessed on the iPads. We would recommend having notebooks, folders, binders, etc. but no specific materials are required.

### Tutoring Services

Roman offers tutoring services to all students through NHS (National Honor Society). NHS student tutor during the Academic Assistance program throughout the year. The schedule for this program is sent out at the end of the first quarter.

### Counseling Services

Having students arrive prior to the warning bell allows them to better prepare for the day. Attendance is important - absences and lates are on the student's transcript.
