<u>Times</u>

9:15am: <u>PERCUSSION ONLY</u>: Get percussion equipment from school (enter in the back entrance of school)

<u>9:30am</u>: <u>EVERYONE</u>: Arrive at Family Dollar in Parade Dress (see below) with instruments (out of the case)

10:00am: Parade begins

Approximately 10:45am: Memorial Day Ceremony at Williams Park (Clara Barton Street)

Approximately 11:15am: Arrive at Williams Park for parent/guardian pick up and sign out.

<u>PERCUSSION STUDENTS</u>: You must have your parent/guardian drive you back to school so you can put your percussion equipment back in the 7-12 building. Parents, please drive around to the back of the 7-12 building and someone will be there to let you in.

Parade Dress

- Black Pants (no wind pants, capris, leggings or sweatpants)
- 7th and 8th Grade Band Polo Shirt (students received these from Mrs. Irwin in September to borrow for the school year; will need to be turned in for inventory by 6/3/24; do not wash these at home)
- Comfortable, black sneakers or shoes
- Please wear hair pulled back away from your face.

Concert/Parade Attendance

Attendance at all concerts and parades is <u>mandatory</u>. Nothing can replace the experience of a performance. As a performance based class, our concert/parade is the culmination of months of work.
