AP Exams Begin May 6

It's the time of year many of our students and teachers have been preparing for! AP Exams begin May 6. This year we have approximately 750 students taking 1460 exams. Students who are testing will be excused in Aeries from their classes all day. They should arrive 45 minutes before their exam time and will be released from their exam once all students are done. In the two weeks before the test, students will receive information regarding their testing location and arrival time via email.
