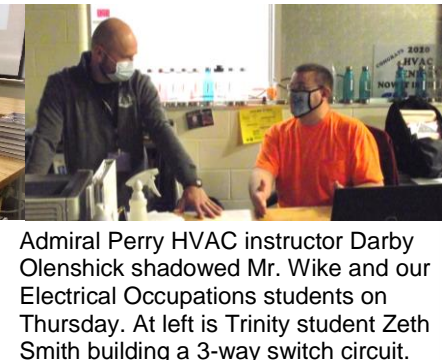

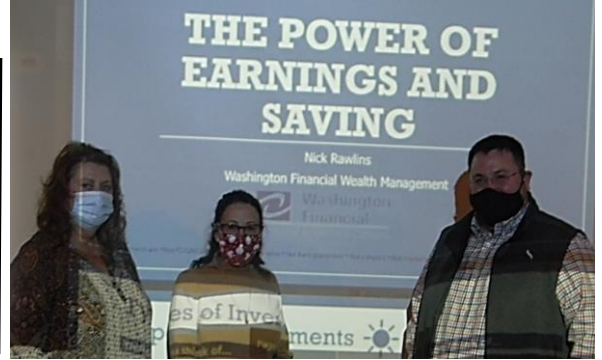
Ethan Johnston (CH), Welding II, employed at Lincoln Manufacturing in Meadowlands, was working on a machine part.

Chance Ritter (T), HVAC, employed by McKean Plumbing & Heating, was changing a gas valve on a rooftop commercial unit.



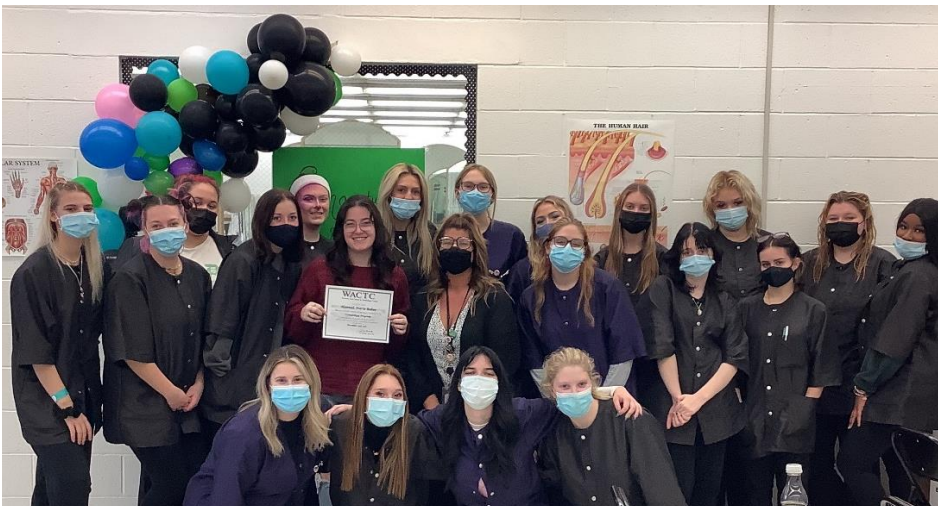
