

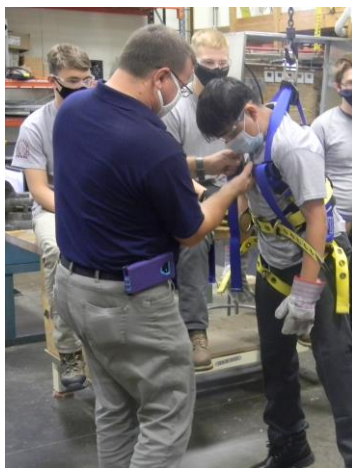
WESTERN AREA CTC UPDATE September 24, 2021

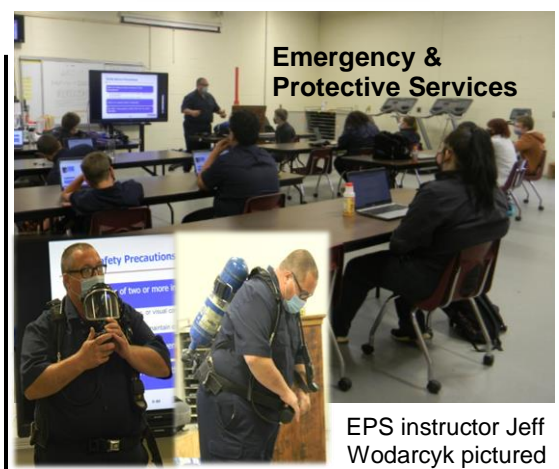
The election for the 2021-2022 SkillsUSA officers was held last week.
