All riders are expected to arrive about 30 minutes before their lesson time to groom and tack up their horse, then stay an additional 15 minutes after the lesson to cool out their horse and put them away. We have a large selection of school horses that suit all levels of riders, so having your own horse is definitely not necessary to take riding lessons.
