Congratulations to Diane Nadeau, SPS Next Superintendent!



At last evening's School Board meeting, the Board unanimously voted to recommend Diane Nadeau, current Assistant Superintendent, to serve as Scarborough's next Superintendent of Schools, beginning on July 1. Over a career in education that has spanned over 30 years to date, Diane has served as an elementary teacher, a literacy specialist, a building leader at both the elementary and middle school levels, and most currently as Assistant Superintendent. She has been employed in Scarborough for the last 7 years.

Diane has placed a high value on her own learning and professional development, having earned her Bachelor's Degree in Elementary Education, her Master's in Literacy Education, a Certificate of Advanced Graduate Study in Educational Leadership, and her Ph.D. in Public Policy.

When asked about her appointment as Scarborough's next Superintendent of Schools, Diane said the following:

It is with great honor and enthusiasm that I accept this opportunity to lead Scarborough Public Schools. Having worked in the district for the past 7 years, I have forged strong relationships with staff, families, and the larger community. I look forward to bringing continued stability and collaboration as we work collectively to support the students of our community now and well into the future.

I am excited to contribute my skill set, experience and passion and to recognize the skills of those around me as we work to increase outcomes for the students of this community and ensure that our educators have the supports in place to do so. Scarborough is so fortunate to have such highly skilled, expert staff across every segment of our organization, as well as strong family and community support for the work of our schools. With everyone working together in the best interest of our students, we will make a meaningful impact.
