Transportation

*Only transportation registration is required, if your child needs to take a bus to GCIT.

- Should your child require district transportation, register at the following link by May 23,

- There is NO need to register if parent/guardian is providing transportation.
- Parents/Guardians may provide transportation and drop students off at GCIT's Summer Bridge Program at any time, Monday - Thursday, between 9:00 AM - 1:00 PM from July 8 - August 8, 2024.
- If a parent/guardian selects district transportation, your child is required to work on their skills from 9:00 AM until 1:00 PM, unless a parent/guardian chooses to pick-up and sign their child out early.

Incentives

- No Cost to GCIT families.
- Free round-trip district bus transportation from home district to GCIT Monday through Thursday from July 8 August 8, 2024.
- Students may attend as many days as they like from 9:00 a.m. -1:00 p.m.
- Students will earn a \$50.00 Walmart Gift Card, if they attend at least 10 in-person sessions, complete 2 hours of work per session, and demonstrate growth in Mathematics and/or ELA.
