



Recap of our year and Naviance lessons:

6th Grade- Strength Explorer. Students answer questions to determine their top 3 strengths.

7th Grade- Career Key Explorer. Students answer questions about Holland Themes.

8th Grade- Career Cluster Finder.

All 8th grade students visited the Western Center in December, Acceptance letters have been mailed. This year, 38 of our students were accepted in all of the programs combined. Many more are on the waitlist.
