
What's UP



The Greenheck Turner Community Center is committed to meeting community needs by providing opportunities for all in the areas of recreation, wellness, athletics, and social activities.



May 1, 2024, was the first day our <u>online portal is open</u> for turf rental. Turf fields will be available for anyone to rent beginning in August. For rentals exceeding four (4) hours, please contact our Facility Scheduling Coordinator to ensure the best customer service and maximize rental space. Fields are available for teams, practices, organizations, and families with no residency requirements.

WHAT MAKES THIS FACILITY UNIQUE?

The full-size turf field will be separated into four fields. Each of the four fields will be 30X70 yards.

There will be more than 1,100 permanent bleacher seats available in the arena. Plus more with portable bleachers and seating throughout the common areas for families and spectators.

There is a large glass viewing window wall on the upper level that allows families and fans to view the turf fields and sit in comfortable areas with natural light and charging stations.

MEETING ROOMS

Four (4) meetings rooms will be available to book for \$25/hour and will accommodate up to 45 people with tables and chairs. These are perfect for board meetings, corporate retreats, and nonprofit presentations.

The Grand Opening will be August 1, 2024. We are ready to show you the new facility, open our doors and invite you in. Watch for more details and times.

On average we have 100 summer soccer volunteers, 30 fall soccer coaches, 40 basketball coaches, 30 flag football coaches, and 40 indoor soccer coaches. SUMMER REC SOCCER is the largest program for youth in the area. This July we will have almost 900 kids, age 4 through 8th grade, enrolled in the five-week session. This program has grown over the years and is successful because of the partnerships with volunteer coaches and parents. Each week teams play on 12 small fields and 6 large fields at the D.C. Everest Middle School Soccer Complex. Teams learn basic rules of soccer, positions, foot coordination and team play.




ADVENTURE CARE



Summer Adventure Care is almost full. We expect to have 250 kids each day for 12 weeks of outdoor adventure fun while providing families with quality care options. Summer Camp will employ 30 staff members. Campers are challenged and supported while going on field

March of 2023 the first construction vehicles arrived on property and the fences around the tennis courts began to come down.

April- May- the front steps were still standing and the bull dozers began to move dirt and earth to prep the site and the front steps of the Greenheck Field House came down.

June-July- brought a lot of moving, flattening and compacting the soil. The cranes arrived and footings were dug. Steel arrived on large trucks and the elevator shaft was built. The steel outline of the "wedge" was built and DCE flag was hung high above the project.

August-September- We flew one of the first fly overs with the drone and you could see the entire project from a birds eye view, and a new name, logo and steel truss sections went up each weighing approximately 65,000-100,000 lbs. October- November- the last piece of structural steel was placed, glass windows were installed in the arena and the roof was insulated.

December- January- drywall was installed and the new arch connected the old lobby to the new portion of the second floor; paint and lights were added. February-March- the grand staircase was installed, meeting room glass and lights in the turf, along with carpet in the common areas was added.









Photos have the power to convey a narrative that words sometimes cannot capture. This project has been recorded through thousands of photographs and video clips. The original time capsule from 1997 unveiled images of classrooms, computer labs, and parking lot upgrades. We hope these photos and videos can capture a moment, serving as a reminder of our community's commitment to this project.

Public Ice Skate

Ice Skating for any age. Rental skates available for a variety of sizes.

Ice Skate Helpers are available for those who need balance assistance. Rental skates available while supplies last. Admission is \$5 per person.

Skate rental is \$5 per person. Skaters under 6th grade need to be with an adult.



Climbing Wall

During public climbs we use 3 TruBlue Auto Belays and when available traditional rope belays. Our climbing wall is located in our ice rink, dressing in layers is suggested. Open to ages 5 and up, must be able to properly fit into harnesses provided and follow certified instructors direction. Admission is \$7 per climber. Climbers must have a waiver on file.



Open Gym

The gyms will be open with volleyball nets up and basketball hoops down. Please purchase a wrist band at front desk for access. Stay for an hour, or stay for all three. \$7 per person. Family Open Gyms \$25 with up to 5 family members.

All Ages Open Gym - One court is designated for children 8 and under while the other court(s) are set up like a regular open gym and monitored by

GTCC staff.

Regular Open Gym – Equipment for soccer, basketball and volleyball are set out and monitored by GTCC staff.

Family Open Gym – Equipment for hands on family group games will be set out such as: dodge ball, parachutes, basketballs, kickball or flag football and monitored by GTCC staff.

Teen Open Gym – This open gym is designed for kids 11-17 years old only. Equipment for regular open gym is set out and monitored by GTCC staff.
