

Dear Klein ISD Parents/Guardians of Current 5th Grade Math Students,

We hope this message finds you well. We are writing to inform you about an important opportunity that may impact your child's educational journey in the upcoming 2024-25 school year.

The Texas Legislature passed Senate Bill 2124 ([SB 2124](#)) regarding advanced mathematics pathways in middle school. Here are the key points to know:

1. **ADVANCED MATHEMATICS PROGRAM:** School districts in Texas are now required to develop an advanced mathematics program for middle school students. This program is designed to prepare students to enroll in Algebra I by the eighth grade.
2. **AUTOMATIC ENROLLMENT:** Rising 6th-grade students who perform in the **top 40% on the 5th-grade STAAR Math test** will be automatically enrolled in one of our advanced math pathways. However, parents have the choice to opt out of this automatic enrollment.

For the 2024-25 school year, Klein ISD will offer three Grade 6 Math pathways to meet the state's requirements:

What to Expect Next:

- **CONFIRMATION LETTER:** If your child qualifies for automatic enrollment based on their performance on the 5th-grade STAAR Math test, **you will receive a separate letter confirming their achievement and placement** in either 6th-grade Advanced Math or 6th-grade Accelerated Math.
- **JULY COMMUNICATION:** Since we currently do not have 2024 STAAR Math scores for your child and schedules for next year are still being finalized, **we will be able to communicate with parents whose child qualifies sometime in July.**
- **OPTING OUT:** If your child qualifies for automatic enrollment, **you will also receive information on how to opt out if you prefer your child to continue in the on-level pathway.**
