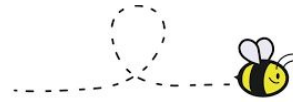

*What do you need to enroll in Community College?*

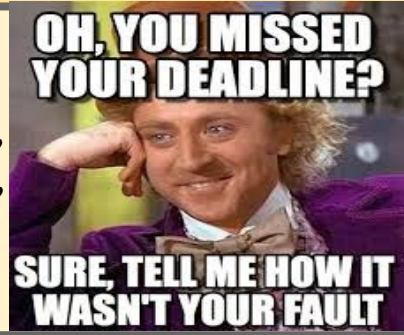
- SS# or green card #
- Transcript is helpful
- Submitted your FAFSA (this is required for the Alameda Promise grant)

[Steps to Enroll page](#)

- 1) Create an account with [CCCApply](#)
- 2) Complete enrollment application to ONE college.
- 3) You will be prompted to register with [IDme](#)
- 4) English & Math Placement Questionnaire (your transcript is helpful)
- 5) [Schedule an appointment with a counselor](#) (Students with an IEP or 504 Plan - [Schedule appt. with a SAS counselor](#))
- 6) Schedule your classes

#### [What can you do this summer to prepare for college applications in the fall?](#)

- 1) Research schools and have a list of schools that you want to apply to.
- 2) Use SCOIR and the scattergram data to make sure you have a balance of schools on your list. That means you have more than just the top 6 UC's on your list.
- 3) Are you applying to schools who will need letters of rec? Plan for that. Do you need a Counselor Rec? Complete the Counselor Packet over the summer.
- 4) Work on your [PIQs](#) and essays over the summer. Need help getting started?

### **WORK PERMITS: Get the job first!**

- 1) Download the attached [work permit form](#) and print it out.
- 2) Fill in the "Minor's Information"
- 3) Have your employer fill out the "employer information" and sign it. Have one of your parents or your legal guardian sign it.
- 4) Scan the front page and email it to Ms. Gwen [gmeyer@alamedaunified.org](mailto:gmeyer@alamedaunified.org). If you don't have a scanner, take a picture of it with your phone (or several close ups so it can be read) and e-mail that to Ms. Gwen.
