Hello Leota Middle School Families!

SAFETY/PARKING LOT

- A kind reminder to parents and students for drop off/pick up. While on campus it is important that we treat each other with kindness and respect. All of our students are watching how we interact with one another.
- Please be aware of your surroundings. There are cars and students constantly moving for a short but busy time with the crosswalk in use.
- Please keep your speed down to 5-7 mph when leaving the area

SBA testing begins this week, please remind your student to arrive at school with their fully charged Chromebook and wired headphones. If they need to borrow headphones, we will have them available. On the topic of Chromebooks, we average about 20 students each day needing to borrow a Chromebook. This takes time away from learning. Please check to see that your student is taking quality care of their device, and bringing it to school. The Chromebooks need to be in their cases, to help reduce the risk of damage and fines.
