**If you accrue debt during the school year and do not pay it within 30 days, your parking privileges can be revoked, and you will have to reapply and repay for parking.

Davie County High School Student Parking Agreement Rules

- 1. Davie County High School is not responsible for damage to your vehicle or items taken from it. Lock your car at all times.
- 2. No oversized vehicles. The vehicle must fit within the parking space, including mirrors, and shall not inhibit traffic flow due to length.
- 3. **Online PowerSchool Registration** is required before receiving the parking pass.
- 4. Unpaid school debts will make you ineligible to purchase a parking permit.
- 5. Safe driving practices must be observed at all times or may result in a loss of parking privileges and school consequences.
- 6. Loss of license due to academic failure will result in the loss of your parking pass.
- 7. Significant discipline and repeated discipline issues, tardies, or absences may result in a loss of parking privileges.
- Parking permits are non-transferable to other students. You cannot sell/loan/give your parking pass to another student. Doing so will result in a consequence.
- 9. A parking pass must be displayed on the rearview mirror at all times.
- 10. Parking passes of Early Graduates and students who withdraw are voided after the student's last date of attendance.
- 11. Students are not to enter or exit through the bus parking lot unless turning left during dismissal. Failure to comply may result in a loss of parking privileges.
- 12. Students should only park somewhere on campus besides their assigned space before school.
- 13. Upon arrival at school, you must immediately enter the building. There can be NO loitering in the parking lot.
- 14. Students are to return to the parking lot only with permission from an administrator. Failure to comply may result in disciplinary action.
- 15. Students with partial schedules who leave early should leave the campus immediately.
- 16. Students and Parents-If you are dropping off or picking up, you must come through the front. The student, staff, and bus lots are off-limits for dropping off or picking up.
- 17. Students are not permitted to leave campus during lunch or to pick up lunch for anyone. Violations may result in the loss of parking privileges.

Fines and Consequences

Replacement Pass (lost or stolen) \$10.00

Parking Lot Violations (includes but is not limited to)

Failure to display a parking permit

Sale/Loan/Give parking permit to another student.

Parking outside of your assigned space

- **1st Offense** 1-2 Days AID or loss of parking pass for one week
- 2nd Offense 2-3 Days AID or loss of parking pass for two weeks
- 3rd Offense 3-5 Days AID or loss of parking pass for the remainder of the semester
- 4th Offense Consequences as deemed appropriate by an administrator
