SOLON SCHOOLS EARN TOP EDUCATION RANKING FROM CLEVELAND MAGAZINE

For the 14th straight year, the Solon Schools have earned the #1 education ranking from Cleveland Magazine in its annual *Rating the Suburbs* issue.

The education rankings are based on a wide variety of school data, including state of Ohio report card indicator achievement and value-added measures, SAT and ACT participation rates and student scores, AP classes and participation rates, National Merit Scholar finalists and commended students, as well as other important information such as student supports, extracurricular activities/clubs and athletic programs offered.

In ranking the city of Solon #6 for Cleveland's 20 Best Places to Live 2022, Cleveland Magazine noted: "Once again, Solon nabbed the No. 1 education ranking. As the third-most diverse suburb in our top 20 with the second most home sales in 2021, Solon continues to be one of the best places to live in the area."

SOLON HIGH SCHOOL AND SOLON MIDDLE SCHOOL SCIENCE OLYMPIAD TEAMS BOTH EARN TOP 5 SPOTS AT NATIONALS

Following their state championships in May, the Solon High School and Solon Middle School Science Olympiad teams both excelled at the national competition May 14. The SMS team took fourth and the SHS team took fifth. Showing the depth of the Science Olympiad program, Solon is the only district with middle school and high school teams both earning top 5 finishes in the nation.

Team members earned medals in many individual events, which tested their science knowledge in a wide range of scientific disciplines from genetics, chemistry, biology and physics to earth and space science and technology and engineering.
