SOLON EARNS TOP MARKS AGAIN IN STATE AND NATIONAL 2019 NICHE RATINGS

The Solon Schools are again topping the nationwide rating of more than 100,000 public school districts and schools released by <u>Niche.com</u>, a community and education comparison resource. The Solon Schools are ranked the #2 Best School District in the nation and the #1 District with the Best Teachers in America.

All Solon schools received A+ ratings and each ranked in the top 5 in Ohio and the top 100 nationally. Orchard, Parkside, Roxbury and Lewis all ranked in the top 10 nationally.

In addition to the national rankings, Solon also earned the #1 rating for Best School District in Ohio and Best Place to Teach in Ohio.

The 2019 Best Schools and Best School District in America rankings are based on a rigorous analysis of many student life and academic data points from the U.S. Department of Education and other sources, which include academics; state assessment and ACT/SAT scores; student-teacher ratio; the quality of colleges students consider; culture and diversity; teachers; resources and facilities; health and safety; clubs, activities and sports; as well as parent and student surveys.

SOLON'S MUSIC IN MOTION SHOWCASED IN DOCUMENTARY

Solon's Music in Motion is one of four show choirs to be featured in a new documentary titled Ohio Show Choir.

The film is a project of Too Pink Pictures, the production company run by filmmakers and Solon High School graduates (and MIM alumni) Hannah and Audrey Leach. Hannah and Audrey are both passionate not only about show choir, but about their experience and arts education at Solon High School, which they credit for helping them to become the "confident creators they are today."

Ohio Show Choir will chronicle a year in the life of four Ohio show choirs – Solon, Garfield Heights, Ross, and Strongsville – from camp and the onset of the competition season (learning the show and meeting new members) through the actual competitions in fall and winter. The filmmakers are looking to provide a compelling behind-the-scenes glimpse into the artistry and level of hard work that goes into every competition season.
