The Board approved the payment of bills totaling \$243,669.87.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

The Board approved the following policy revisions:

Policy 8310 – Public Records- This is a minor change to our public records policy to allow the entire board to be a part of the public records commission. It also aligns our policy with current practice and state law.

Policy 4415 – Severance Pay- This is a change to our severance pay policy to apply the policy to all of our support staff. The original policy is being expanded to include classified non-bargaining unit employees such as aides and monitors.
