TREASURER'S REPORT

The Board approved the payment of bills totaling \$19,681.88.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

The Board approved the original permanent appropriation of funds for the Solon City School District to provide for current operating expenses and other expenditures during fiscal year ending June 30, 2023.

A payment to Ohio Schools Council in the amount of \$3,600.00 for legal hotline services administered through the Ohio Schools Council was Board approved.

The Board approved the parent-student handbooks for the 2022-23 school year. A resolution that the school district does not intend to provide career technical education in grades 7 and 8 for the 2022-23 school year was passed by the Board.

Bus routes were approved for the 2022-23 school year.

A resolution to approve the following bus drivers for annual driver certification by the Solon City School District for the 2022-2023 school year under OAC 3301-83-06 B5 was approved. This certifies that said driver is of good moral character, is at least 18 years of age, and is physically and otherwise qualified to drive a school bus as required by rules of the Ohio Department of Education for the Solon City School District for the school year ending 2023.

The Board approved two non-district pupil activity permits and 14 supplemental contracts for the 2022-23 school year.

The Board approved the following individuals as contract building substitutes for the 2022-23 school year:

The Board approved 14 individuals as substitutes on an as needed basis for the 2022-23 school year.

Tuition reimbursements were approved for 13 individuals in the amount of \$9,714.80.
