REGULAR MEETING

TREASURER'S REPORT

The Board approved the payment of bills totaling \$1,396.63.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

The Board approved administrative, director and supervisory contracts and the appropriate salary schedules. The Board approved a two-year contract between Antoine Campbell and the Board of Education of the Solon School District as principal of Solon Middle School commencing August 1, 2021, and ending July 31, 2023.

The Board held a public hearing in consideration of re-employment of employee Thomas Pinizzotto for one year as noted in the collective bargaining agreement between the Solon Board of Education and Ohio Association of Public School Employees complying with Ohio Revised Code 3307.353. Members of the public were invited to provide input to the Board on the issue of re-employment of Thomas Pinizzotto. After input, the Board will act on the resolution at a future meeting.

The Board rehired retired employee Richard Alaimo for one year as noted in the collective bargaining agreement between the Solon Board of Education and Ohio Association of Public School Employees complying with Ohio Revised Code 3307.353.

The resignations of Holly Becker, aide for Solon High School; Cynthia Bomeli, security guard at Roxbury Elementary School; and Alicia Byers, food service at Solon Middle School effective June 3, 2021, were approved.
