SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

The Board approved a contract between the Solon Board of Education and the Solon Education Association for the period of September 1, 2017 through August 31, 2021. The Board of Education and the Solon Education Association have agreed on a new four-year contract. The salary for the four years will be as follows:

- 1. 2017 18 0% base raise and 5% cash payment
- 2. 2018 19 2% base raise and 5% cash payment
- 3. 2019 20 0% base raise and 5% cash payment
- 4. 2020 21 2% base raise and 5% cash payment

Salary increases from fiscal year 2012 through 2021 will average 1.1% for that period. Healthcare contribution by employees will be increased to 16% in the 20/21 school year.

The Board approved new contracts and appropriate salary schedules for administrators, directors and supervisors receiving identical changes as SEA.

The Board rehired retired employee Margaret Misch for one year as noted in the collective bargaining agreement between the Solon Board of Education and the Solon Education Association in compliance with Ohio Revised Code 3307.353.

The Board approved membership in the Ohio High School Athletic Association for the 2017-18 school year. An increase for the school lunch program for the 2017-18 school year raising the price for secondary buildings to \$3.65, \$3.40 for the elementary buildings was approved.

Sarah Miller, Olivia Potash and Rebecca Smith were approved as home instruction tutors for the 2016-17 school year.

For the ninth straight year, the Solon Schools have earned the No. 1 education ranking from Cleveland Magazine in its annual *Rating the Suburbs* issue.
