## REGULAR MEETING

### TREASURER'S REPORT

The Board approved the payment of bills totaling \$42,502.26. The Board approved the original permanent appropriation of funds for the Solon City School District to provide for current operating expenses and other expenditures during fiscal year ending June 30, 2017.

### SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

The Board rehired retired employee David Van Etten for one year as noted in the collective bargaining agreement between the Solon Board of Education and the Solon Education Association in compliance with Ohio Revised Code 3307.353.

The 2016-17 parent-student handbooks were approved. The Board approved an increase for the school lunch program for the 2016-17 school year raising the price for secondary buildings to \$3.55, \$3.30 for the elementary buildings. Changes to the current strategic plan were approved.

An agreement between the Solon Board of Education and Ohio Schools Council in the amount of \$1,443.97 for programs administered through the Ohio Schools Council as noted below was approved.

#### SOLON HIGH SCHOOL NAMED TO NEWSWEEK AMERICA’S TOP HIGH SCHOOLS 2016 RANKINGS

Solon High School is one of only 33 Ohio schools named to the 2016 Newsweek America’s Top High Schools list. Solon ranked #105 nationally (6<sup>th</sup> highest in Ohio) among the 500 high schools that made the list for this year.

Newsweek’s rankings rate public high schools on a variety of data points to identify the schools across the nation that are best preparing students for college. The list is derived through a two-

step process. The initial threshold is based on student achievement data states report to the U.S. Department of Education. Those schools scoring highest on the resulting “achievement index” then submit comprehensive data on various indicators of college readiness, including:

- School demographics and availability of counselors
- College acceptance and enrollment
- SAT and ACT participation and performance
- AP, IB and AICE participation and performance
- Dual enrollments
