- The District maintains a Wi-Fi network within the interior of our school buildings and offices.
- The District cannot provide assurance that the interior Wi-Fi network will be online without interruption for the entire school day; therefore, the District assumes no liability if privately-owned device loses connectivity.
- The District does not operate a Wi-Fi network on the exterior grounds of District property; therefore, the District assumes no liability if privately-owned device loses connectivity.
- The District strongly encourages the parent/guardian to carry a dedicated cellular data plan for the device and this privately-owned cellular data plan serves as the primary method of internet connectivity while on District property.
- The District is not responsible for the reliability of cellular service on District property; therefore, the District assumes no liability if the privately-owned device loses connectivity.
