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Bathroom Problems	Brian Siesto	40 min	<p>Brian Siesto shared with the group his ideas on how to address the student bathroom issues at the high school. Brian offered the following ideas as deterrents:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● To remove the hallway doors</li> <li>● Revamp the suspension protocol to increase the current time of out-of-school suspension from 5 days to a Superintendent’s Hearing for possession of marijuana/THC/alcohol. Depending on the results of the hearing, the out-of-school suspension may be extended, involve participation at The Learning Center, and/or may require drug/alcohol counseling.</li> <li>● Adult supervision outside the student bathrooms especially during peak times.</li> <li>● Researching the addition of an E Pass System</li> <li>● Researching the addition of vape detectors</li> <li>● Realizing the importance of changing disruptive behaviors and getting students help for addictions.</li> </ul>
