Take in this tour's highlights

London

Participate in a workshop to discover some of the most influential, yet least well known, figures in Black British history and culture. Discuss their trials and triumphs, and consider how to apply some of their core values to our daily lives.

Attend an evening theater performance to enjoy England's long history of stage productions.

Follow your expert local guide to some of the city's best sites. Snap a picture of Big Ben from the banks of the River Thames, check out the lively five-way intersection at Piccadilly Circus, and marvel at the Baroque domes and spires of St. Paul's Cathedral.

Brixton

Take a day trip to the South London district of Brixton, a longtime cultural hub for Black communities with strong Afro-Caribbean roots. Follow your expert local guide and learn how residents' diverse backgrounds came together to produce a unique perspective on community activism, street art, music, food, and more.

Enjoy lunch at Brixton Market, London's most diverse and vibrant market. Over 100 independent vendors representing over 50 nationalities combine to create a welcoming and inclusive environment for all.

Paris

Take a guided tour focused on Black history. Led by an expert local guide, the tour will explore past and present Black communities in Paris, including how the St. Germain district became home to writers, artists, and jazz musicians escaping segregation in the U.S.

Cruise up and down the Seine River, which cuts right through the center of Paris and has served as the city's heartbeat for centuries.

Spend an afternoon exploring Chateau Rouge, or Little Africa. Through markets, cuisine, and fashion, discover how a variety of African communities express their identities in this vibrant neighborhood.

Stroll through the Latin Quarter, one of the oldest districts in Paris, known for its lively atmosphere, bustling bistros, and beautiful gardens.
