-Must graduate with a 3.0 GPA or better

-Must be pursuing a career in the fire service, EMS, a medical field, or a trade

Completed applications and attachments must be submitted on or before May 1st of each year, and will be awarded for the subsequent Fall registration. Awards will be made payable to the school or program you will be attending. Awards will be distributed on or before August 15th of each year.
