

# Washington State Graduation Requirements

## Credits

**Successful completion of a one-semester course earns half (.50) credit.** Some of the course requirements may be completed by courses cross-credited through departments other than those listed below. Students are required to attempt and pass **24-credits** in order to graduate. **\*\*\* If you are in SpEd math or qualified on your IEP, you must have a 4<sup>th</sup> year of math. \*\*\***
