<p><b>August/Sept.</b></p> <p>Check graduation and college admission requirements</p> <p>Register for SAT I, II or ACT</p> <p>Finalize college list</p> <p>Consider carefully your responsibility if applying for Early Decision or Early Action</p> <p>Plan college visits and interviews</p> <p>Return senior profile form, activity sheet and parent brag sheet as soon as possible.</p> <p>Log into Naviance to make sure you have access</p> <p>Ask teachers for letters of recommendations</p> <p>Athletes wishing to play Division I or II sports apply on-line for NCAA @ <a href="http://www.web3.ncaa.org">www.web3.ncaa.org</a></p>	<p><b>October</b></p> <p>Take SAT I, II or ACT</p> <p>Work on college essays</p> <p>Review transcript with Counselor</p> <p>Plan college visits and interviews (remember follow-up thank you letters)</p> <p>Attend college fairs and meet with college representatives when they visit our school</p> <p>If applying Early Decision be award of DEADLINES</p> <p>File FAFSA online at <a href="https://fafsa.ed">https://fafsa.ed</a> and/or any other financial aid forms by October 1<sup>st</sup></p>	<p><b>November</b></p> <p>Take SAT I, II or ACT</p> <p>Send early decision/Action Applications – deadlines typically Nov. 1<sup>st</sup> or Nov. 15<sup>th</sup></p> <p>Look around for financial aid sources</p> <p>Research sources of outside private scholarships</p> <p>Fill out a transcript request form each time you apply to a college</p>	<p><b>December</b></p> <p>Take SAT I, II or ACT</p> <p>Finish all applications and essays</p> <p>Check all application deadlines and submit applications early. December 1<sup>st</sup> is a great date to use.</p> <p>Talk with graduates who are home from college</p>	<p><b>January</b></p> <p>Submit midyear grade request forms to the Guidance Office</p> <p>Finish any remaining college applications</p> <p>Take SAT I, II or ACT</p>
<p><b>February</b></p> <p>Ask Guidance to send mid-year grades to colleges</p> <p>Check/apply for outside scholarships</p> <p>Check to make sure you have submitted all necessary forms and applications for financial aid</p> <p>Apply to Community College if this is your choice</p>	<p><b>March</b></p> <p>Continue to explore college if necessary</p> <p>Send any new materials which may be helpful for acceptance</p>	<p><b>April</b></p> <p>You should have received your SAR – Student Aid Report from FAFSA</p> <p>Review your college responses and aid offers with your parents and decide where you wish to attend</p> <p>Write or email withdrawal notices to colleges you will not be attending</p> <p>Send in your deposits</p>	<p><b>May</b></p> <p>Take AP exams if applicable</p> <p>May 1<sup>st</sup> is generally the notification deadline used for acceptances</p> <p>Notify the Guidance Department where to send your official high school transcript</p>	<p><b>June</b></p> <p>Graduation</p> <p>Best of Luck!</p>
