Discussion of ELA Curriculum Selection:

Christy Baril, the ELA Curriculum Coach for Grades K to 5 presented the information for the PILOT process they used for K-2 for a new ELA Curriculum.

The pilot team used a rubric to determine which curriculum was best, they previewed 3 different curriculums, CKLA (Amplify), EL (Imagine Learning) and ARC.

After a full assessment by the ELA Curriculum committee it was determined that CKLA (Amplify) will provide the best curriculum for K-2 and the cost would allow for a Pilot program in Grade 3. At this time McAlister administration and staff are looking at what program would be best for 4th and 5th grade with a possibility of a homegrown curriculum using Right To Read supplements.

Discussion of Math Curriculum Selection:

Heather Goldstein, the Math Curriculum Coach for Grades K-5 presented the information for the PILOT process they used for K-5 for a new Math Curriculum.

Through the process it was determined that Bridges was the best program going forward and will be implemented fully in Grades 3-5 next year with a portion called "Number Corner" to be used in Grades K-2.

A full implementation schedule was shared showing all of the Professional Development time that will be needed for a successful implementation.
