
PRAYER OF THE WEEK


St. Damien De Veuster

St. Damien De Veuster is also known as St. Damien of Molokai. He was a priest that was assigned to the Hawaiian Islands in 1864. At that time, Hawaii had an outbreak of leprosy and to prevent the spread of the disease, the government deported all those sick to the nearby island of Molokai. Damien agreed to be sent to Molokai to tend to the spiritual needs of those on the island even though the mission was a possible death sentence. Damien brought hope back to this land that was filled with despair. After 16 years of serving in Molokai, he contracted leprosy and passed away.



SANTO DE LA SEMANA



St. Damien De Veuster

San Damián de Veuster también es conocido como San Damián de Molokai. Era un sacerdote que fue asignado a las islas hawaianas en 1864. En ese momento, Hawaii tenía un brote de lepra y para evitar la propagación de la enfermedad, el gobierno deportó a todos los enfermos a la cercana isla de Molokai. Damien aceptó ser enviado a Molokai para atender las necesidades espirituales de los que estaban en la isla a pesar de que la misión era una posible sentencia de muerte. Damien devolvió la esperanza a esta tierra llena de desesperación. Después de 16 años de servicio en Molokai, contrajo lepra y falleció.
