St. Anthony-New Brighton School District is holding a special election on September 7, 2017, and asking residents to vote on a ballot question for Wilshire Park Elementary School.



Strong Schools, Strong Communities

St. Anthony-New Brighton School District has a history of strong schools and our academics receive state and national recognition.

Young families are moving into our District for our schools and resident student enrollment continues to increase. In 2017, Wilshire Park Elementary School serves 705 students and 94% are residents. **In the 2025-2026 school year, Wilshire Park is projected to serve between 796-963 resident students.** Additional learning spaces are needed to accommodate our resident learners.

What is the plan for the referendum

The referendum funds a plan for additional classrooms, gymnasium, expanded cafeteria, bathrooms, larger media center, and a secured entrance at Wilshire Park to welcome and serve our increasing enrollment of resident students.

As resident enrollment increases at Wilshire Park, how will that impact the middle and high school?

Wilshire Park serves 705 students and 94% are residents. Resident enrollment at Wilshire Park Elementary School would need to exceed 900 students to impact class size at St. Anthony Middle School and exceed 1050 students to impact class size at St. Anthony Village High School. Wilshire Park is projected to serve between 795-963 students in the 2025-2026 school year.
