

May River Elementary School (Quackenbush Architects and Planners/Thompson Turner Construction)

- Design Development (DD's) documents cost estimate review follow-up discussions occurred on April 30, 2024 with BCSD, Architect and CM; Team is working on cost revisions to ensure project is within budget
- The report for the HVAC geothermal well conductivity testing was received and after further review the design team will explore the use of a traditional water source heat pump system that will use cooling towers and boilers
- Construction Documents progress submittal is scheduled to be received in June 2024
- Civil permits are ongoing; Site permit is scheduled to be received in November 2024
- Other Item(s) To Note: None at this time



- MB Kahn Amendment No 04 (Phase 1A and 1B) was approved by the Board on April 26, 2024 with a GMP of \$80,170,995 and a Substantial Completion date of June 19, 2026; Amendment No 04 supersedes Amendment No 03 (Phase 1 Site Work); Phase 1A work includes construction of a 3-story classroom addition of approximately 144,000 SF; Phase 1B includes selective demolition, foundation modifications between addition and existing building, plumbing modifications at group restrooms, steel, roofing, relocation of corridor walls and finishes
- Phase 2 (Renovation of Existing "D" Wing and ROTC) and Phase 3 (Renovation of Both Gyms): Design Development commenced in April 2024
- Phase 4 (Renovation of PAC): Design Development is scheduled to begin in Q3 2024
