2023-24 School Improvement Plan Impact Review #3

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School improvement is an ongoing process and requires consistent monitoring to ensure that action steps are being implemented with fidelity to meet school improvement goals. The following is a review of our plan and process.

Creekview School Improvement Plan Goal #1.

Increase the amount of completed credits attempted by all students by 2% per year over the next 3 years, starting with the 21-22 school year.

1. Action Plan Strategies Implemented

We continued our 6-week meetings, continued our 8th - 9th grade vertical teaming, and continued our practice of having the Student Success Coach contact the parents of students who are failing while also working with teachers to identify ways to help students during the semester. We also do an attendance review every six weeks and contact parents of students with chronic absenteeism.

2. Current Progress

Failure rates have been slightly higher this semester, but our absentee rates are also high. Teachers have been dealing with a higher rate of absences while still trying to hold students accountable. The last few weeks have seen a renewed interest from our students and parents, but our teachers are trying to manage normal class work with the push towards exams.

3. Now What?

Each semester we notify parents of our End of Semester procedures, grading timelines, and attendance procedures. We are also isolating the students who are in danger of failing during the school day, so we assist them with their grades in the last few weeks. Students who qualify for Course Extension will be identified along with students who may need a Summer School option.

4. What do you need?

We continue to identify time for the students who need support around testing and other activities.

5. Reflections?

Our attendance issues occur in waves. Usually, 3 weeks after a break or start of the semester we see an increase in attendance issues. Whether the absences are excused or unexcused, students need to be present to learn, and poor student attendance takes a toll on our teachers.

Creekview School Improvement Plan Goal #2.

Increase the graduation rate of Students with Disabilities 2% per year over the next 3 years, starting with the 21-22 school year.

1. Action Plan Strategies implemented associated with Goal 2.

We have continued our 6 - week reviews, Student Success Coach interventions, directed Professional Learning Communities with Special Education teachers in the content area meetings. This time of year typically has increased communication with parents, and adjustments when needed to IEPs.

2. Current Progress

Our Special Education graduation rate improved more than 10% in the last 2 years, and we are having success by reducing our resource classes and moving more students into the team-taught setting.

3. Now What?

We continue the dialog between the CCSD Department of Special Education, Creekview Student Success Coach, and counselors. We have made significant improvements with our communication in school which has benefitted students. We have seen success with Special Education students in our team-taught classes and look to transfer those strategies into other areas.

We are looking forward to an increased and improved dialog with Creekland to better understand and coordinate our Special Education practices and methods.

4. What do you need?

Continued time to vertical team with Creekland, and possibly identify some Professional Development time to work with Cherokee County School District Special Education personnel, and Creekland Middle School.

5. Reflections?

We are pointed in the right direction and look forward to a continued dialog with Creekland so we can serve our students during the transition from 8th to 9th grade.
