

Staffing Updates for Next Year:

Thank you to all our 5th grade parents for confirming their 6th grade decisions. We are looking forward to having our first 6th grade class next school year 2024-2025!

Interviews for our 2 teachers/Immersion TOSAs are underway and we will provide a staffing update soon!

We have conducted interviews for our teacher vacancies for next school year. Our candidates were promising! We look forward to conducting interviews for 2 new positions for next school year shortly after Spring Break. We will be hiring 2 full time staff members to split the following positions: Immersion TOSA and 6th grade teacher.

This means that next year's FGIS 6th graders will have 2 teachers. They will be with one teacher for the first portion of the day, and with the other for the 2nd portion of the day. While these teachers are not in the classroom providing instruction, they will support our program as Immersion TOSAs!

Important Update Regarding our School Parking Lot:

From, Monday, 4/8 until Friday, 5/3 we will have solar panel construction happening at our school. Our front of the school parking lot will be a <u>drop off/pick up zone ONLY</u>. The parking lot will only be available for staff and for the 3 purchased parking spots that were auctioned for the year.

We kindly ask that during this time parents/caregivers park on Bermuda Dr. but do NOT park on the white zone as it is a drop off/pick up zone only. If you park on the residential neighborhood side please refrain from blocking drive ways or fire hydrants. Thank you!
