WHAT IS GREAT PARENTS, GREAT START?

The Great Parents, Great start program is a parent involvement and education program for families with children from birth to age five who live within the Eastern Upper Peninsula Intermediate School District. The program is funded from a grant through the Michigan Department of Education. Services are at no cost to participating families. Great Parents, Great Start promotes school readiness skills, parenting education, and early care to ensure children are developmentally prepared for school.

SERVICES PROVIDED

- Provides parents with methods to enhance parent-child interaction
 - Provides learning opportunities
 - Provides information to access community services
 - Provides developmental screenings
 - Provides school readiness skills
- Provides social opportunities through parent-child playgroups for children birth through age 5 -Connection for parents and children, as needed, to other community resources and Early Childhood programs and services.
- Child Development information for birth through age 5.
