Competitive Salaries

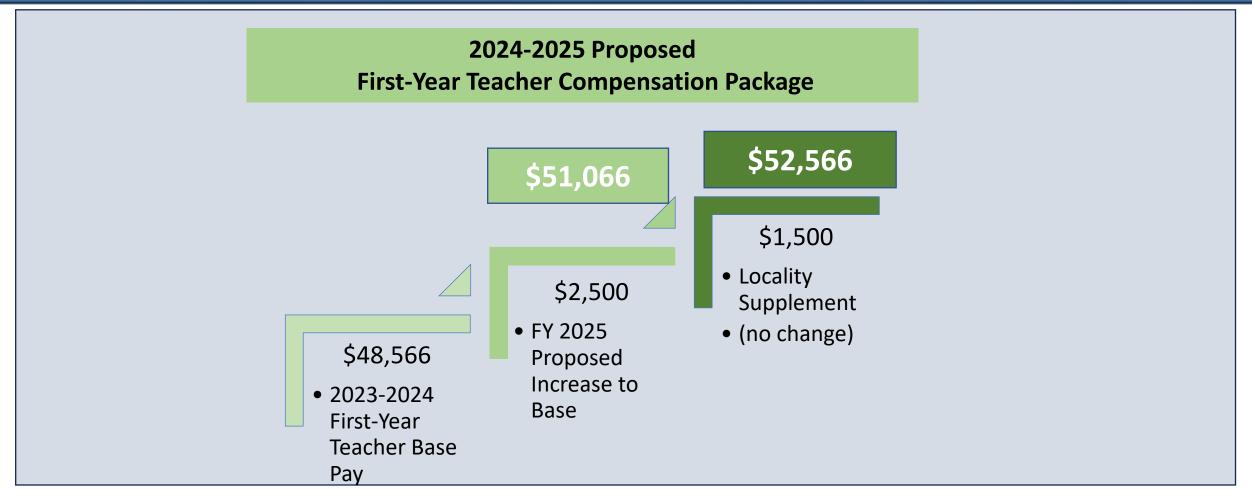




- \$2,500 Increase to each cell of the Teacher Salary Schedule
- 3% Cost of Living Classified, Professional and Administrative Employees
- Annual Step Increase for all eligible employees
- Maximum step increasing to 28 steps for all employee types
- Locality supplement remains \$1,500 for all eligible employees

The Senate has passed its version of the education budget

The budget is currently in the House for a second review since this legislative body initiated the bill.

No material changes in state revenue are expected.

The projection of final funding from the State will arrive in mid-June.
