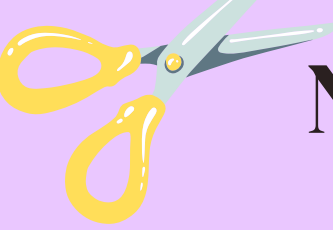
PAWS April Character Trait: Integrity
