Building and Construction Plan

DISTRICT-WIDE FULL-DAY K 2025-26

- With the loss of anticipated revenue from the Siemen's property, district administration is proposing utilizing current facilities to achieve full-day kindergarten.
- Once the Siemen's property sale is final, we can revisit next steps regarding construction projects, including 5/6 Center consideration.



BEAVER CREEK ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

PROJECTED FDK NEED

- One additional classroom

PLAN TO ADDRESS NEEDS

- Proposed construction project
 - Full-day K – 1 classroom
 - iDesign – 1 classroom
 - Band/orchestra – 1 classroom
 - Music – 1 classroom
 - Learning Support – 2 classrooms
(currently shared with ESL)
 - Flexible Space – 2 classrooms
(to address “bubble” grades)



BRADFORD HEIGHTS ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

PROJECTED FDK NEED

- One or two additional classrooms

PLAN TO ADDRESS NEEDS

- Shift two current autistic support classrooms to WB
- Remove ACP

NOTES

- Addresses current space needs for ESL and learning support service



BRANDYWINE WALLACE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

PROJECTED FDK NEED

- One or two additional classrooms

PLAN TO ADDRESS NEEDS

- Remove ACP
- Two current classrooms could be served by converting small group instructional space (SGI), leaving two additional FDK space opportunities

NOTE

- Do not need to move the autistic support classroom



EAST WARD ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

PROJECTED FDK NEED

- Two additional classrooms

PLAN TO ADDRESS NEEDS

- Remove ACP
- Second grade smaller than third grade

NOTE

- Could create one or two classrooms within library



LIONVILLE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

PROJECTED FDK NEED

- Two additional classrooms

PLAN TO ADDRESS NEEDS

- Remove ACP from large group instruction space (LGI)
- Split LGI into two classrooms

NOTE

- Could convert the extra-wide hallway near the nurse's suite into small group instruction space (SGI)





PICKERING VALLEY ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

PROJECTED FDK NEED

- One or two additional classrooms

PLAN TO ADDRESS NEEDS

- Remove ACP
- Currently have one empty classroom

SHAMONA CREEK ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

PROJECTED FDK NEED

- One or two additional classrooms

PLAN TO ADDRESS NEEDS

- Flex some programs in small group instruction rooms (iDesign, ESL, Learning Support)
- Remove ACP

NOTES

- SC has a large storage space that could be repurposed to a small group instruction space if necessary





SPRINGTON MANOR ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

PROJECTED FDK NEED

- One or two additional classrooms

PLAN TO ADDRESS NEEDS

- Remove ACP ; and/or
- Other classrooms currently being utilized as office space



NOTES

- Bump-out spaces provide opportunities to flex office/SGL space as classroom space
- Projected enrollment indicates a possible decrease in classroom space needed in upper grades

UWCHLAN HILLS ELEMENTARY

PROJECTED FDK NEED

- One or two additional classrooms

PLAN TO ADDRESS NEEDS

- Remove ACP
- Small group instruction (SGI) space

NOTE

- Could transform large group instruction (LGI) behind the main stairwell into a classroom



WEST BRADFORD ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

PROJECTED FDK NEED

- Two or three additional classrooms

PLAN TO ADDRESS NEEDS

- Proposed construction project
 - Full-Day K – 3 classrooms
 - iDesign – 1 classroom
 - Art – 1 classroom (LS into current space)
 - Learning Support – 2 classrooms (3 total)
 - Autistic Support – 2 classrooms (2 from BH)

NOTES

- Shifting two AS classes from BH to WB enables us to address special education and English as a second language services space needs
- Two current classrooms at WB that are not being used for traditional classrooms, provide two flex classrooms should a “bubble” grade occur



BENEFITS

CURRENT PROPOSAL



Doesn't require \$80M+ in construction costs



Provides Full-Day K in 2025-26 school year



Lower staffing costs than 5/6 proposal
