STUDENT HEALTH SERVICES AND REQUIREMENTS

The Bristol Warren Regional School District will have a student health program designed to help maintain students' health and detect any conditions impeding their learning and growth.

Annually in June, the School Committee will appoint a school physician and a school dentist. Nurse-teachers and school aides will staff the health rooms in each school, under a plan of organization supervised by the superintendent.

Qualifications, licensing, and certification requirements applicable to the respective health professionals under state law and regulations will be observed, and the health services and education program will be designed to meet state standards.
