NEGOTIATIONS LEGAL STATUS

The primary right of the School Committee, in negotiating with employee units, is to retain and exercise its authority to govern the school system. The Committee's primary duty in negotiations is to meet and confer in good faith with representatives of the bargaining units.

Negotiations between the School Committee and the recognized employee bargaining units will be conducted under the provisions of applicable state law: in particular, under Title 28, Chapter 9.3, pertaining to certified teachers and others with a state-issued certificate below the rank of assistant principal; and under Title 28, Chapter 9.4, pertaining to clerks, custodians, and aides.
