SCHOOL COMMITTEE NEGOTIATING AGENTS

To represent it in negotiating with staff bargaining units, the Committee will have a subcommittee on negotiations, and may also retain the services of an attorney. The subcommittee will consist of three School Committee members selected by the Committee chairman. In the event of a conflict of interest by a member of the Subcommittee, the member will request of the Chair, an alternate be appointed. The Superintendent and the Director of Administration and Finance will serve as advisors in the negotiations process.
